# What to bring to your appointment:

- Patient information form (filled-out)
- Medical / vision insurances card(s)
- Picture ID (i.e., drivers license/California ID)
- List of medications and known allergies
- Your current prescription glasses or sunglasses
- Contact lens prescription or boxes (includes size, shape, and power)
- Be prepared to pay your co-pay prior to service (cash, credit card or check)

You will most likely have your eyes dilated during your exam which can make your vision blurry and light sensitive for a few hours. This can affect your ability to work and drive. Dilating your eyes causes your pupils to widen, allowing more light in, and providing a better view of the back of your eye. This enables our physicians to detect diseases and conditions at their earliest stage. If you are considering purchasing glasses you may wish to arrive a few minutes early to pick out your frames prior to your exam.

# **Paying for Services:**

- If you are paying for your visit with cash/check/credit card payment is due on the day of your visit.<sup>4</sup>
- Co-payments for insurance are due on the day of your visit, prior to your exam.
